Resolution on campaign for a 21 hour week

As a reduction in the working week and the redistribution of work among the unemployed and underemployed are vital for the physical, social and psychological health of our societies, and a ready answer to the crisis facing us, Left Unity adopts the transition to a 21 hour week with no loss of pay as a goal and campaign priority. To this end Left Unity will:

- 1. Form a working group to develop plans and proposals for campaigning for a 21 hour week.
- 2. Aim to publish regular articles on the subject from members in different areas of employment and life
- 3. Write to unions, professional bodies, academics and campaign groups proposing the organisation of a conference in 2014 to launch a national campaign for a shorter working week.
