Resolution on campaign for a 21 hour week

As a reduction in the working week and the redistribution of work among the unemployed and underemployed are vital for the physical, social and psychological health of our societies, and a ready answer to the crisis facing us, Left Unity adopts the transition to a 21 hour week with no loss of pay as a goal and campaign priority.

To this end Left Unity will:

1. Form a working group to develop plans and proposals for campaigning for a 21 hour week.
2. Aim to publish regular articles on the subject from members in different areas of employment and life
3. Write to unions, professional bodies, academics and campaign groups proposing the organisation of a conference in 2014 to launch a national campaign for a shorter working week.
